



This distribution of designations was done keeping in mind the strengths, expertise, and interests of each member, ensuring that every individual played a meaningful role in shaping the NGO.



### **Fund Collection for Documentation & Expenses**

Once the designations were finalized, attention turned to the most immediate requirement — funds for the registration and documentation process. It was agreed that the expenses would be shared equally among trustees to reflect unity and equal ownership of the NGO.

#### The collected funds were used for:

- Registration Fees for NGO documentation.
- Legal and Administrative Costs related to drafting and filing.
- Initial Stationery, Communication & Setup Expenses for smooth functioning.

The collective contribution was not just financial support, but also a symbol of shared responsibility and trust. Each trustee willingly came forward, reflecting their dedication and personal commitment to the cause.
