Punjab Flood

About the Flood and its lossess

The devastating floods that struck Punjab in mid-2025 caused widespread damage across several districts, severely impacting agriculture, infrastructure, and livelihoods. According to official and media reports:

- **Overall Loss:** The total estimated loss across the state has crossed ₹20,000 crore, making it one of the most destructive floods in recent years.
- **Agricultural Damage:** The paddy crop alone suffered losses worth nearly ₹7,500 crore, due to prolonged rainfall, flooding, and a fungal disease outbreak known as false smut. Thousands of farmers faced complete crop failure.
- **Health Infrastructure:** The state's health facilities faced damage worth around ₹780 crore, including more than 1,200 dispensaries and wellness centers, as well as medical equipment and essential supplies.
- **Power Infrastructure:** The Punjab State Power Corporation Limited (PSPCL) reported damages worth ₹102.58 crore – over 2,300 transformers and 7,000 electricity poles were destroyed or damaged, disrupting supply in many regions.
- **Human Impact:** More than 2.5 lakh people across 12 districts were directly affected, with many displaced from their homes and in urgent need of medical and humanitarian support.

Trustees' Meeting

Before the camp, a special meeting of RCF Trust's trustees' was held in New Delhi to review the flood situation in Punjab and plan an effective medical relief response. The trustees unanimously resolved to send a dedicated team of doctors and volunteers to the affected areas and provide essential medical assistance, medicines, and health awareness programs.

About the relief camp

In a compassionate effort to support the flood-affected communities of Punjab, the Raah to Cure Foundation (RCF) Trust organized a two-day free medical camp in **Amritsar** and **nearby regions**. The initiative aimed to provide essential healthcare facilities and free medicines to those suffering from the recent floods.

This camp was organized under the supervision of the **village sarpanchs**. The team of doctors provided services in various **villages of Ajlana Tehsil, Amritsar District**. Special focus was given to **Guniwal and Thopa**, where the community was severely affected by the floods. In addition, the team also visited nearby rural areas such as **Kohli and Majitha**, ensuring that the medical needs of the local people were met.

The camp received an overwhelming response from the local people, who expressed deep appreciation for the dedicated team of doctors and volunteers.

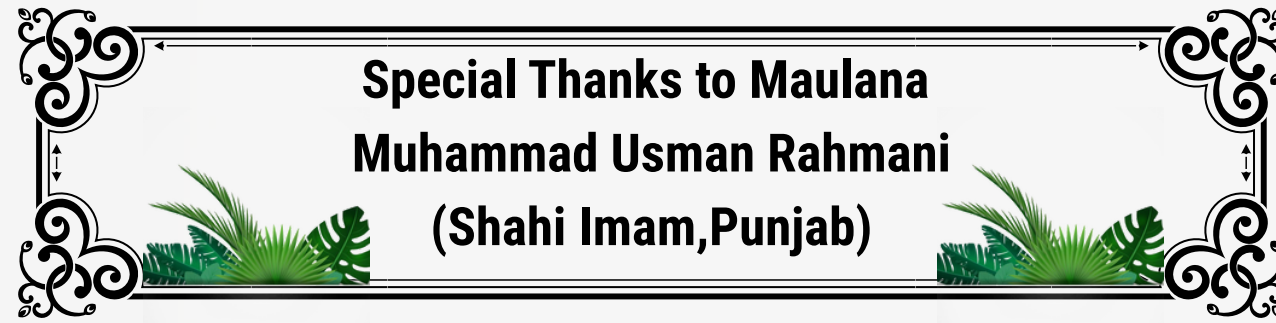

In this free medical camp, **Dr. Qasim, Dr. Ghanim Khan and Dr. Shavez** served as consultants. In addition, **Dr. Rafiqat Ali** (President, RCF Trust), **Dr. Muhammad Arif** (General Secretary, RCF Trust), and **Dr. Adnan Shamim** (Treasurer) not only provided medical assistance but also managed all administrative affairs. Furthermore, **Dr. Ahmad Mubashir, Dr. Azharuddin, Dr. Jamal Sheikh, Dr. Bashar, Dr. Ghufraan, Dr. Naushad, Dr. Danish, Dr. Adeeb, Dr. Ayan Firoz**, and ophthalmologist **Dr. Sameer** also rendered their valuable services.

During this two-day free medical camp, underprivileged people received consultations with doctors, **free medicines, blood pressure tests, sugar tests, eye examinations, and medicines completely free of charge.** In addition, methods to prevent mosquito-borne diseases and related medicines were also distributed in ample quantities.

The camp received tremendous support from the local community, especially from **Thopa** local leaders: **Thavi Singh, Arvinder Singh, Gurmeet Singh, Jonat Singh, Amarjeet Singh, Yusuf Basheer Ahmed, Baldev Singh, and Haji Mohammad Basham**, whose contributions were warmly appreciated by the doctors.
